What's a Tad Pull?

A Tad Pull is an unofficial, non-titleing event designed for dogs which have been introduced and are comfortable wearing a harness and hitched to a cart, but not ready for off leash testing. Tad pull is not intended to be an introduction to draft work, it is designed for dogs and handlers to work on-leash in a test environment. **Dogs must be at least 18 months of age to participate.** The exercises will be modified versions of the [NCA DD/TDD test exercises](#)

TAD PULL EXERCISES:

Basic control: consisting of a simple healing pattern and recall at the end of a six-foot leash.

Harnessing and Hitching: the handler will place the harness on the dog and then hitch the harness to the cart.

Maneuvering Course: Same as NCA Draft Dog Test(90-degree, RT, 90 degree LT, low narrows, high narrows, removable object, back-up, sweeping turns, and change of pace)

In-sight one-minute stay: at the end of a six foot leash, harnessed and hitched to a cart.

Freight-Haul: a ¼ mile freight haul with or without weight- (handlers choice)

Get your AKC Trick Dog or Canine Good Citizen Title at the Draft Test

AKC Trick Dog and CGC evaluator(s) will be on hand at the test site to evaluate Novice (TKN), Intermediate (TKI) and Advanced (TKA) levels. As well as Canine Good Citizen (CGC) and Canine Good Citizen Advanced (CGCA). There will be a \$10.00 evaluation fee; proceeds will go to the draft test.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

ENTRY LIMITATIONS:

Saturday, May 18, 2019: All Breed entries will be limited to a total of 10 Teams DD/TDD with teams counting as one entry. The club reserves the right to cancel the test if a minimum of three entries are not received. Entry slots will be filled according to postmark date, Priority will be given to untitled dogs, followed by re-qualifiers. **All entries will be accepted beginning with postmark beginning April 12, 2019. Entries close at 7pm Monday, May 6, 2019** or when the entry is filled, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted. In the event that entries exceed the maximum entry limit, an alternate list will be established and filled according to order in which it was received, with untitled dogs taking priority, regardless of postmark date. Alternates will be notified immediately should an opening occur.

Sunday, May 19, 2019 entries for **Tad-Pull** will be limited to 7 dogs. **Please note: Untitled Newfoundland's will be given priority. Entries close Monday, May 6, 2019 at 7:00pm.**

ENTRY FEES: \$45.00 per entry for All Breed DD/TDD. \$15.00 per entry for Tad Pull. Please make checks payable to Pacific Northwest Newfoundland Club or PNNC.

ENTRY Gifts and Trophy: All entries will receive an entry gift and complementary food and drink. DD Qualifiers will receive certificate and trophy, Tad-Pull qualifiers will receive a certificate.

POLICY ON DOG AGGRESSION

Any dog that, in the opinion of the Event Committee, attacks a person or a dog resulting in an injury and is believed by that committee to present a hazard to persons or other dogs, shall be disqualified.

REGULATIONS

This test will be using the Newfoundland Club of America test regulations, revised March 2018, effective July 1, 2018. Entrants are responsible for obtaining and reading these Test Regulations. They are available on the NCA Web page: www.ncanewfs.org

TEST SITE

Description: The draft test rules state that the handler should use equipment suitable for the test.

Champoeg State Park is a public park. Situated on the South Bank of the scenic Willamette River, Champoeg's acres of forest, fields and wetlands re-create the landscape of a bygone era. The test site consists of varied terrain including grassy areas, **an active disc golf course**, wooded paths, gravel and paved areas. The freight haul may include gentle and moderate hills and may be near water. May in the Pacific Northwest can have varied weather throughout a given day. Prepare for both rain, cool and warm weather. Anyone having further questions concerning the test site should contact the test secretary for details.

Directions to the Test Site:

Champoeg State Park is located off I-5 near Newberg, Oregon which is approximately 25 miles North of Salem, Oregon and 25 miles South of Portland, Oregon.

From the South: I-5 North towards Salem/Portland. Take Exit 263 toward Brooks/Gervais. Turn Left onto Brooklake Rd NE towards Willamette Mission State Park/Hopmere. Turn Right onto River Rd. NE. Continue onto French Prairie Rd NE. Turn Right onto Champoeg Rd. NE. The destination will be on your left. Oak Grove Shelter #4

From the North: Take Exit 278 onto Ehlen Rd. toward Newberg. Turn Right onto Ehlen Rd. NE toward Donald, Champoeg State Park. Turn Right onto Case Rd. NE. Continue onto Champoeg Rd. NE. The destination will be on your Right. Oak Grove Shelter #4

Parking at the Test Site: Champoeg State Park charges \$5.00 per day or Annual State Park Permit.

Practice: The Test Site is open to the public and you may practice from 7am-9pm any day before the test. There will not be a course set up. Parking fees apply. Please observe the Park's "leash required" policy.

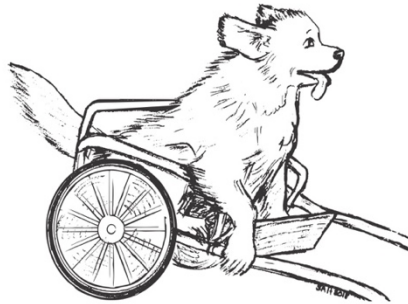
